ORDER

The Arkansas Cemetery Board (“Board”) held its quarterly meeting on June 12, 2014, pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 20-17-1005 and Rule 5 of the Rules of the Arkansas Cemetery Board. Among the matters considered was a request by Cobb Cemetery Corporation on behalf of Memorial Park Cemetery to ratify a proposed change in trustee from Dan Ritchie, Dan Caldwell, and Billy Curl as trustees to Regions Bank. Upon consideration of the testimony of the witnesses, the exhibits, and all other matters presented, the Board hereby finds and concludes:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Memorial Park Cemetery is located in Blytheville, Arkansas and is licensed by the Board as a perpetual care cemetery as defined by the Cemetery Act for Perpetually Maintained Cemeteries, Ark. Code Ann. §§ 20-17-1001—20-17-1030 (“Act”).
2. The cemetery is owned and controlled by Cobb Cemetery Corporation.
3. On May 12, 2014, Cobb Cemetery Corporation filed a proposed permanent maintenance trust fund agreement with the Board. This permanent maintenance trust fund agreement would replace the cemetery’s current permanent maintenance trust fund agreement and would establish Regions Bank as trustee.

4. The proposed permanent maintenance trust fund agreement, which involves a change of trustee, meets all statutory requirements as set forth in Ark. Code Ann. § 20-17-1013(d)(1) and (2).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. A new permanent maintenance trust fund shall be executed in writing and approved by the Board. Ark. Code Ann. § 20-17-1013(d)(1) and (2).

ORDER

The permanent maintenance trust fund agreement proposed by Cobb Cemetery Corporation establishing Regions Bank as trustee of the Memorial Park Cemetery permanent maintenance trust fund agreement is hereby approved.


